Cure4CF National Grant Round is now OPEN!

We are thrilled to announce our inaugural grant funding round is now open and we need your help to spread the word!

Managed and administered in partnership with the National Foundation for Medical Research and Innovation (NFMRI), **Cure4CF will invest a minimum of \$750,000 to**

advance medical innovations in the area of Cystic Fibrosis (CF) over the next three years.

This research will focus on developing therapies or cures that will result in a material increase in average life expectancy of people with CF.

The grant will be named the 'Cure4 Cystic Fibrosis Foundation – Barbara Stow-Smith CF Innovation Grant' in honour of the Foundation's very first bequest.

Grants will be awarded for a period of up to three years, with funding commencing in late 2019 to early 2020. Expressions of interest close Friday 29th March 2019.
